DECLARATION OF GREGORY T. ARNOLD ON BEHALF OF HAGENS BERMAN SOBOL SHAPIRO LLP IN SUPPORT OF CLASS COUNSEL’S MOTION FOR AWARD OF ATTORNEYS’ FEES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

I, Gregory T. Arnold, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a partner with the law firm Hagens Berman Sobol Shapiro LLP (“HBSS”). I respectfully submit this Declaration in support of Class Counsel’s Motion for an Award of Attorneys’ Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses (the “Fee and Expense Application”) in connection with the services rendered in this action and the proposed class action settlement with Defendants.¹

2. The statements herein are true to the best of my personal knowledge, information and belief based on HBSS’ books and records and information received from its attorneys and

staff. HBSS' time and expense records are prepared and maintained in the ordinary course of business.

3. This firm serves as counsel of record for named plaintiffs Iron Workers District Council of New England Health and Welfare Fund and Utah-Idaho Teamsters Security Fund.

4. I am the partner who primarily oversaw HBSS' involvement in this action. HBSS' time and expense records (including, where necessary, backup documentation) were contemporaneously recorded and kept in my firm's records. They have been reviewed to confirm both the accuracy of the entries as well as the necessity for and reasonableness of the time and expenses expended in this litigation. The time reflected in HBSS' lodestar calculation and the expenses for which payment is sought are reasonable in amount and were necessary to prosecute this action and resolve the settlement before the Court.

5. Set forth below is a summary reflecting the amount of time (after any applicable reductions) HBSS attorneys and professional staff worked on the Action from the inception of HBSS' involvement in the case (beginning in May 2024) through the date of the settlement agreement's execution on September 25, 2025, the current billing rates applicable to such work, and the corresponding lodestar value of that work. The schedule was prepared based upon daily

time records maintained by HBSS attorneys and professional support staff in the ordinary course of business, and the lodestar calculations are based on the firm's current hourly billing rates.²

6. The services HBSS performed on behalf of the putative class include, but are not limited to, the following: (1) Assisting in the identification and retention of experts, particularly on issues relating to causation; (2) Conducting document reviews of materials produced by the defendants; (3) Assisting in researching, drafting, and filing various motions, particularly relating to issues of advice of counsel and possible waiver of privilege; (4) Participating in overall case strategy decision-making; (5) Managing the online document database; (6) Drafting and negotiating discovery protocols; and (7) Engaging in multiple meet-and-confers with defense counsel and counsel for non-parties concerning compliance with discovery requests.

7. The total time for which my firm is requesting an award of legal fees is 479.9 hours. The total lodestar value of these professional services is \$400,935.00.

8. The above hourly rates for HBSS' attorneys and professional support staff are the firm's current hourly rates. The time and lodestar spent preparing the Fee and Expense Application were also excluded from the above values.

9. The firm's lodestar figures do not include charges for expense items. Expense items are billed separately and such charges are not duplicated in the firm's current billing rates. Further, expense items do not contain any general overhead costs and do not contain a surcharge over the amount paid to the corresponding vendor(s).

10. As detailed and categorized in the below schedule, HBSS has incurred a total of \$57,757.00 in expenses from inception through June 2, 2026 for which Class Counsel seeks reimbursement from the settlement fund.
