**DECLARATION OF LABEAT RRAHMANI ON BEHALF OF KOREIN TILLERY LLC
IN SUPPORT OF CLASS COUNSEL’S MOTION FOR AWARD OF ATTORNEYS’
FEES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

I, Labeat Rrahmani, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am an attorney with the law firm Korein Tillery LLC (“Korein Tillery” or “the Firm”). I respectfully submit this Declaration in support of Class Counsel’s Motion for an Award of Attorneys’ Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses (the “Fee and Expense Application”) in connection with the services rendered in this action and the proposed class action settlement with Defendants.¹

¹ “Defendants” means Teva Pharmaceutical Industries Ltd.; Teva Pharmaceuticals Usa, Inc.; Teva Branded Pharmaceutical Products R&D, Inc.; and Norton (Waterford) Ltd.

2. The statements herein are true to the best of my personal knowledge, information and belief based on Korein Tillery's books and records and information received from its attorneys and staff. Korein Tillery's time and expense records are prepared and maintained in the ordinary course of business.

3. Korein Tillery serves as counsel of record for New York State Teamsters Council Health & Hospital Fund ("NYST"), who serve as a named plaintiff in this action.

4. I am the attorney who oversaw the Firm's involvement in this action. Korein Tillery's time and expense records (including, where necessary, backup documentation) were contemporaneously recorded and kept in Korein Tillery's records. They have been reviewed to confirm both the accuracy of the entries as well as the necessity for and reasonableness of the time and expenses expended in this litigation. The time reflected in Korein Tillery's lodestar calculation and the expenses for which payment is sought are reasonable in amount and were necessary to prosecute this action and resolve the settlement before the Court.

5. During the course of this litigation, and as detailed herein, Korein Tillery worked on assignments that it was specifically directed to perform by Class Counsel.

6. Set forth below is a summary reflecting the amount of time (after any applicable reductions) Korein Tillery attorneys and professional staff worked on the Action from the inception of the case through the date of the settlement agreement's execution on September 25, 2025, the current billing rates applicable to such work, and the corresponding lodestar value of that work. The schedule was prepared based upon daily time records maintained by Korein Tillery attorneys and professional support staff in the ordinary course of business, and the lodestar calculations are based on the firm's current hourly billing rates.

7. The services Korein Tillery performed on behalf of the putative class include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a. Korein Tillery attorneys and staff evaluated the merits of potential claims; reviewed client purchase records from 2014 through 2022 to determine standing under various state laws; and communicated with co-counsel regarding case viability and strategy.
- b. Korein Tillery attorneys drafted and revised the initial complaint and prepared an amended complaint incorporating updated plaintiff information.
- c. Korein Tillery attorneys reviewed and responded to Defendants' Rule 11 letter in coordination with co-counsel.
- d. Korein Tillery attorneys reviewed and analyzed the Court's orders, including on Defendants' motion to dismiss.
- e. Korein Tillery attorneys and staff drafted and revised Plaintiffs' responses and objections to Defendants' first requests for production; prepared for and attended meet-and-confer conferences with Defendants on discovery disputes;

coordinated client document collection; and responded to Defendants' correspondence raising discovery concerns directed at Plaintiffs.

- f. Korein Tillery attorneys also participated in case budgeting, client retention efforts, and strategy conferences with co-counsel.
- g. Korein Tillery staff collected and organized client purchase records, analyzed data for indirect purchasers to assess claim eligibility, and redacted protected patient information from potential production materials.
- h. Korein Tillery attorneys and staff established docket monitoring systems, reviewed scheduling orders and case management directives, and coordinated with local counsel on filings in the District of Massachusetts.

8. The total time for which my firm is requesting an award of legal fees is 110.60 hours. The total lodestar value of these professional services is \$112,860.00

9. The above hourly rates for Korein Tillery attorneys and professional support staff are the firm's current hourly rates. The hourly rates for attorneys and professional support staff in my firm are the same as the regular rates charged for their services in contingent fee matters. The time and lodestar spent preparing the Fee and Expense Application were also excluded from the above values.

10. The Firm's lodestar figures do not include charges for expense items. Expense items are billed separately and such charges are not duplicated in the firm's current billing rates. Further, expense items do not contain any general overhead costs and do not contain a surcharge over the amount paid to the corresponding vendor(s).

11. As detailed and categorized in the below schedule, Korein Tillery has incurred a total of \$1,387.61 in expenses from inception through June 2, 2026 for which Class Counsel seeks reimbursement from the settlement fund.
